Psychoanalytic interpretation, both clinical and as applied to other fields, deals with the observation and analysis of imagery: in dreams, symptom formation, symbolism, and fantasy. These two fields officially came together in 1910, when Freud published the first psychobiography of an artist (namely, Leonardo da Vinci), and they met again four years later in Freud's short essay on the Moses of Michelangelo.
